The year 2024 was a very special year. We were elected Horse Sport Family 2024 at Indoor Brabant, and on top off it all, Highway TN NOP won the prestigious Rolex Grand Prix of Den Bosch. Furthermore, Grandorado TN NOP became Champion of the Netherlands in Deurne 2024. Unfortunately Grandorado TN NOP could not start at the Olympic Games at the last moment, but we have enjoyed top sport at the Olympics in Paris and especially the performances of Cassini Gold offspring Imagine and Kim Emmen.

In addition, we are very proud of the KWPN stallion Johnson, who is number 1 on the FEI world ranking for the third year in a row, with by far the most number of offspring (80), performing at Grand Prix level. Furthermore, a large number of our stallions are in the top 100 of the WBFSH jumping rankings.

In addition to our current foundation stallions, Verdi, Eldorado van de Zeshoek, Johnson, Colestus and Carambole, our current toppers are fast becoming foundation stallions. Think of I'm Special de Muze, Cassini Gold, Grandorado TN, Hernandez TN, Highway TN and Poker de Mariposa TN who are listed as up-and-coming purveyors of national and international jumpers.

In addition to proven stallions, we will offer a number of very talented and genetically interesting young stallions in 2025, for both the dressage and jumping directions. These are Bocelli TN, Louision Manciais, Pacorro TN and Vino for Fun.

This year we will again host our stallion show at PSC Lichtenvoorde in Vragender on March 29, 2025 from 2:00 pm, so you can see the stallions in person or attend online at www.clipmyhorse.tv.

Won more than €3,500,000 in prize money

Verdi TN is the best example of sport and breeding going hand in hand. For years, Verdi combines his career as a sire with a sports career at the very highest level. In 2016, Verdi and his rider Maikel van der Vleuten jumped three clear rounds during the Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro! He already competed at the major championship; European Championships in Madrid 2011, Olympic Games in London 2012, European Championships in Herning 2013, World Equestrian Games in Caen 2014, and European Championship in Aachen 2015. In addition, Verdi took part in no less than three World Cup Finals, in which he finished twice as 6th and once as 7th! Verdi is now enjoying his well-deserved retirement and can look back on Olympic team silver, team gold at the WEG, European team gold, and many other prizes. Besides his own performances, Verdi's pedigree is also outstanding.

Sire Quidam de Revel is one of the most influential sires of the past decades and the same goes for Verdi's legendary grandsire Landgraf I. Verdi was bred out of the famous Holsteiner damline 747a, which also produced Calato, VDL Bubalu, Vingino, and many more world-class showjumpers and stallions.

Verdi's offspring prove themselves time and again. Son Chaplin won three Global Champion Tours, Evita SG became 2nd in the GP of Falsterbo, Fleurette won the Worldcup in Washington, Varoune became the champion of Belgium and Ibelle and Cuidam participated in the world championships in Tryon. After dominating the showjumping sport for many years, Verdi is now one of the top sires worldwide.

World's best sire

Powerhouse Eldorado van de Zeshoek meets all the expectations in both sport and breeding. Ridden by Willem Greve, the son of **Clinton** was successful at Grand Prix level. In breeding, Eldorado van de Zeshoek is undoubtedly a foundation sire. Daughter Killerqueen VDM managed to win both the Rolex Grand Prix of Aachen and Calgary.

Eldorado van de Zeshoek's dam **Bijou Orai** competed at 1.60m level with French rider Olivier Perreau. After Willem Greve took over the reins from Eldorado, they won the Grand Prix of Roosendaal. Thereafter, he finished eighth on the Dutch Championships in Mierlo, he won the 1.50M class at Outdoor Gelderland, was placed second in the GP of Saint Lô & the 1.50 m class of Ommen and jumped multiple clear rounds in the Nations Cup of Lummen & Sankt Gallen.

In every way, I'm Special de Muze is unique. First of all his pedigree: sire **Emerald** has had countless victories with Harrie Smolders, including the World Cup of Washington in 2015, the Nations Cup of Falsterbo in 2015, and the Nations Cup of Aachen and Gijon in 2013.

I'm Special Muze's dam **Walnut de Muze** has also won a lot all over the world, ridden by Harrie Smolders. Just think of Grand Prix and Nations Cup wins in Madrid, Dublin, Doha, Wellington, Mechelen, and Calgary. Ridden by Christophe Barbeau, Granddam Qerly Chin jumped the World Cup final in Milan and was a reserve for the Olympic Games in Athens 2004. Afterward, Qerly Chin turned out to be one of the best broodmares ever in Belgium.

I'm Special de Muze won the Sires in Den Bosch with Zoi Snels, the 1.50m class in Neumunster, and became 9th in the 3* GP in Herning.

CASSINI GOLD

Grand Prix stallion with excellent offspring

Cassini Gold is a new Grand Prix stallion and an exciting sire in Team Nijhof's stallion string. Cassini Gold was a huge jumping talent as a young horse and was sold to Mexico, where he jumped to 1.60m level with Julio David Vainer. His first crop of offspring are particularly striking for their performances and his pedigree is also very interesting for Dutch and Belgian breeding.

Cassini Gold stood out as a young horse for his superb jumping technique, reflexes and scope. His talent was soon noticed and the Cassini I son left for Mexico. With Mexican showjumping rider Julio David Vainer, Cassini Gold eventually jumped successfully up to 1.60m Grand Prix level and his jumping talents still proved remarkable even at the highest level.

In addition, his pedigree is very interesting with foundation sires **Cassini I**, **Contender** and **Ahorn Z**. Cassini Gold's damline also produced many top showjumpers; for instance, Cassini Gold is the half-brother of the brilliant showjumper **Caretina de Joter**, who jumped at the highest level with Pius Schwizer and Edwina Tops-Alexander and stood out for her flashy jumping technique. In addition, Cassini Gold is also the half-brother of the 1.60m showjumper Cambito van de Helle. Granddam Glocke produced the 1.60m showjumper Latino.

In his first years at stud, Cassini Gold produced a limited number of offspring, but his success is undeniable. Examples include Grand Prix jumpers such as Indian Gold of young Swedish rider Ida Selin, Imagine of top Dutch rider Kim Emmen, IV Willem of British young rider Oliver Fletcher, Golden Lady of Jennifer Hochstadter and K.I. Guru of Keira Stoute.

Carambole himself is a son of the foundation sire **Cassini I**, who already produced so many top stallions, such as **Cumano**, Berlin and Cabrio van de Heffinck. Carambole's grandsire Concerto II brings in the valuable genes of Contender and great-grandsire Sir Shostakovich xx contributes some thoroughbred input.

Carambole is among the greats of his generation. In sport, the impressive stallion performed phenomenally with Willem Greve from a young age; his spectacular victory in the Grand Prix of Jumping Amsterdam will be remembered by many. But also his Grand Prix victories in Knokke, Drachten, Hadelot and Wierden were admirable, as were his performances in the Nations Cups of Rotterdam, La Baule, Falsterbo and Copenhagen. Once again in 2020, Carambole showed to belong to the world's very best by finishing 4th in the Global Champions Tour of Valkenswaard.

In breeding, Carambole convinces in every way. Many offspring are already jumping at top level, of which Hello Senator of Scott Brash is probably the best known. As a 7-year-old Hello Senator won bronze at the World Championships in Lanaken and later he became a world star with, among others, a victory in the Grand Prix of St. Tropez, second place in the Rolex Grand Prix of Geneva, and third place in the World Cup of Stuttgart. Other Grand Prix jumping offspring of Carambole include Elien (Katharina Offel), Frasier (Dennis van den Brink), Elina (Charles Luyckx), Frederiks (Christoph Könemann), Formidable (Willem Greve), La Caramba (Rodrigo Pessoa) and Flambeau (Harry Marshall).

The Cornet son who continues to surprise the jumping world

The Grand Prix stallion Colestus has been high-profile from a young age and is proving himself in breeding on all fronts. The **Cornet Obolensky** son already produced several famous showjumpers, the most famous of which is probably Kent Farrington's Greya. Under Farrington, Greya won the Rolex Grand Prix of La Baule in 2024 and the mare is among the greatest talents of her generation. Chuck Marienshof Z was also particularly successful last year; under Lars Kersten's saddle, he jumped clear in several Nations Cups and was crowned EEF Horse of the Year. A jumping phenomenon by Colestus is also the Katharina Rhomberg-ridden Colestus Cambrigde, who competed in the Olympics in Paris at the age of only nine. Nayel Nassar's Jiminy Cricket and Christian Ahlmann's Classic Dream also jumped impressive win sums.

At Ludger Beerbaum's stable, Colestus was an unparalleled jumping talent from day one, jumping at 1.60m level at a young age. As an eight-year-old, under Marco Kutscher and Ludger Beerbaum, he jumped several prizes at CSI5* level and later, under Christian Kukuk, Colestus also achieved sensational results at the highest level.

LORD FAUNTLEROY

A hallmark stallion with exclusive genes and champion blood

With the arrival of Lord Fauntleroy, Team Nijhof adds a particularly interesting foundation stallion to its breeding stock. Lord Fauntleroy not only jumps at top level himself, but also has offspring in the heaviest work and brings with him an exclusive gene pool. Saddled by Gilbert Böckmann and Markus Brinkmann, Lord Fauntleroy himself jumped up to 1.60m level, notable for his scope and good jumping style.

Especially his offspring put Lord Fauntleroy on the map in recent years. Despite a very limited number of offspring, we already see well-known horses at the highest level such as Let's Go FZ by Giacomo Casadei, Ride Smart Legend of Life by Andreas Schou Lord Heinrich by Jörne Sprehe and perhaps the most famous, Looping Luna by Steve Guerdat. In 2024 alone, Looping Luna won the CSI Twente Grand Prix under the top Swiss rider, two CSI5* 1.55m classes in both London and Windsor, two 1.50m classes in Fontainebleau and Geesteren and two 1.45m classes in Gorla Minore. Furthermore, Looping Luna was second with Guerdat in a 1.50m class at Spruce Meadows, Calgary and third in a 1.50m class at Bordeaux in 2024.

Lord Fauntleroy's breeding power is easily explained given his blood structure. Sire Lord Pezi was also a sparsely used stallion, but today is considered one of the most successful stallions in the L-dynasty in recent decades. Indeed, almost 10 per cent of his offspring jumped at 1.60m level, including Lord Pezi Junior (Pedro Veniss), Little Pezi (Mario Stevens) and Lord Pepsi (Paul Estermann). Dam's sire Contendro I in turn also produced a legion of successful showjumpers and further back can be relied on the mainstay Argentinus

She is still the only mare to have produced three Olympic showjumpers: Jus de Pomme, Quintus and Tresor d'Opaline. In addition, Opaline des Pins produced a total of five 1.60m showjumpers and five approved stallions, including the very influential Richebourg and Shogoun II. Her most famous son is of course the aforementioned Jus de Pomme - individual and team gold at the Atlanta Olympics in 1996. Telstar's damline has also brought numerous successful horses in recent years. A fine example is O'Bailey van het Brouwershof N.O.P.; one of Maikel van der Vleuten's top horses and Dutch champion.

With his enormous jumping talent and outstanding pedigree, the 2019-born Telstar is a very interesting addition to Team Nijhof's stallion collection. The KWPN and AES approved stallion brings the best of Belgium and France to the Netherlands.

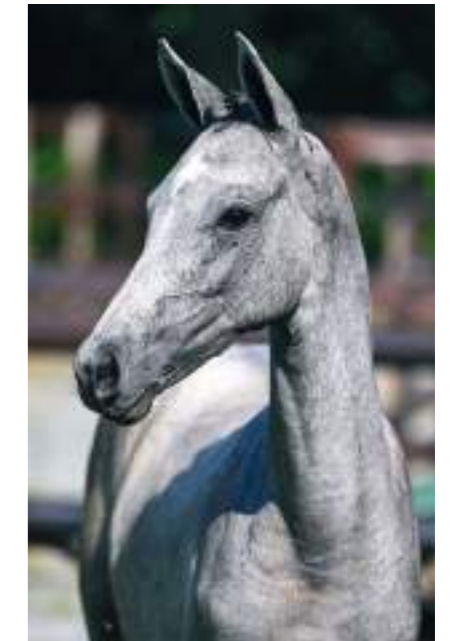

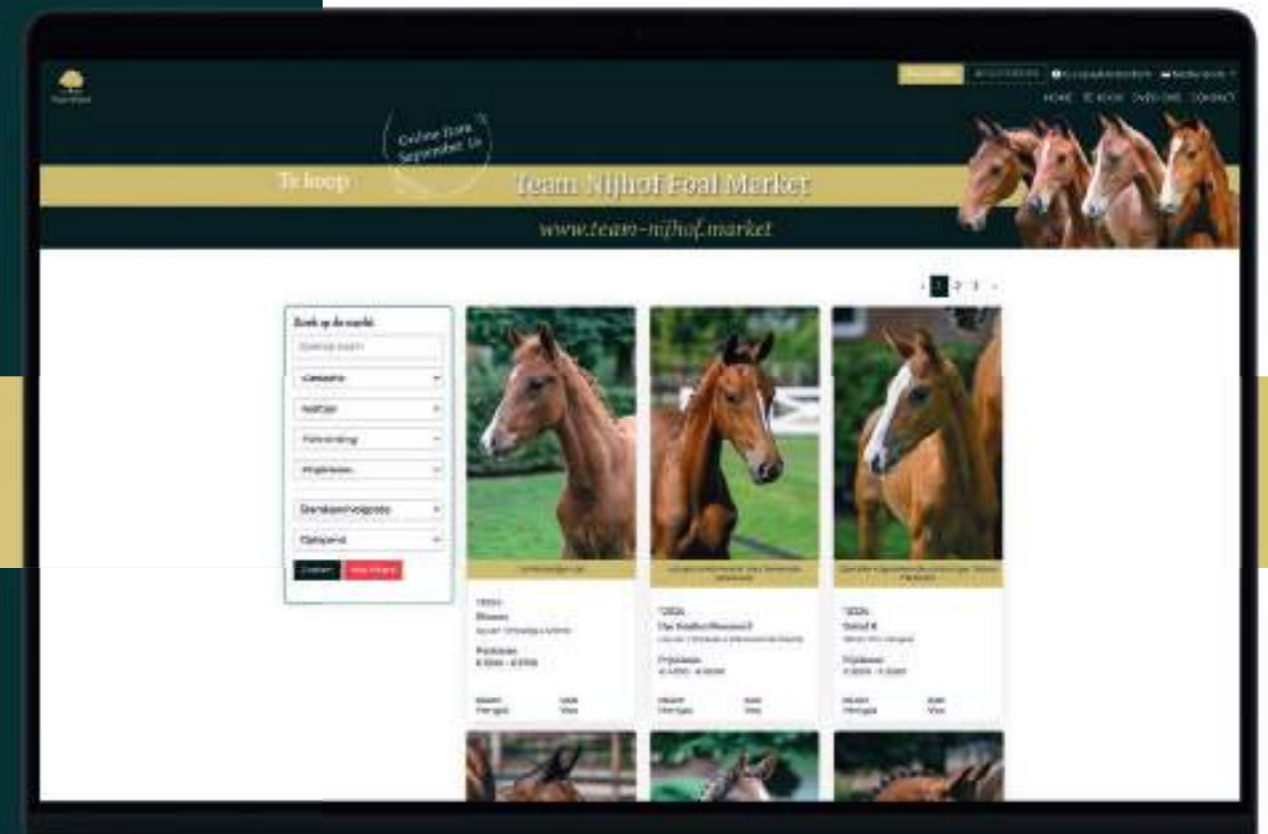

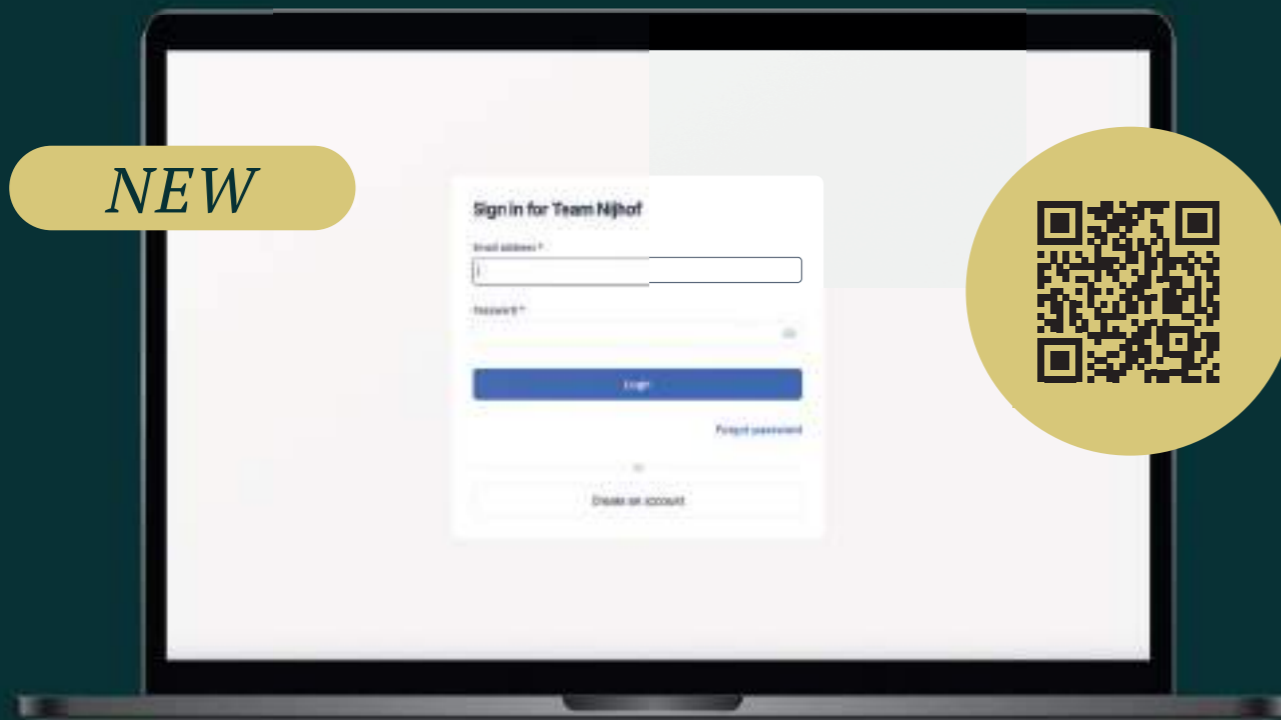

When you order fresh or frozen semen from SWS Nijhof B.V. the general terms and conditions of the Dutch 'Bond van Hengstenhouderds' 2025 in the Netherlands are applied.

Semen of our stallions can be ordered on a daily basis until 09.30. The order should include the name and life number of the mare and the full address of the mare-owner.

Before the first semen order, the full stud fee is due. Your invoice must be paid before we ship the semen to you. We will refund part 2 of the breeding fee when you send us the veterinary certificate of the barren mare. Non-pregnant mares must be reported before **1st October 2025** with a written statement from the veterinarian and be sent by email or post.

For mares who are not in foal, a written not in foal-agreement issued by the veterinarian should be handed to Team Nijhof before October 1st 2025, or the full fee will automatically be charged.

If the mare was in foal and it turns out that she is not pregnant after October 1. 2025, the credit can only be used the following year (2026) with the same stallion, unless otherwise agreed.

SWS Nijhof BV does not sell single straws; only pregnancies (except for Heartbreaker and Clinton straws). You pay the stud fee per mare. Straws that have not been used, remain in the ownership of SWS Nijhof BV and have to be returned to Nijhof by the end of the breeding season, or can be used when paid for.

Frozen embryo's obtained through fresh semen of frozen semen must be paid in the year of the semen delivery.

The breeding management of the mares is provided by veterinarian Jeroen Smak from DAP Berkelzicht.

Mares are inseminated entirely at the cost and risk of the mare-owner.

The shipping costs and NVWA-costs for the Netherlands and abroad will be charged to the mare-owner.

For inseminations from stallions that stand at a stud station abroad/or own straw, an insemination- compensation will be charged.

In the event of late payment, the invoice amount will increase by fees and penalty interests and any collection costs.

By ordering and taking semen, the mare-owner declares to have knowledge of these general conditions and agrees with the insemination and payment conditions.

Stud station S.W.S. Nijhof B.V. in Geesteren accepts no liability whatsoever for damage, sickness, or injury to people, animals, transportation, or otherwise.

SWS Nijhof B.V. will not be liable for any shortcomings with regard to deliveries of semen, except in case of intent and recklessness. SWS Nijhof B.V. will carry out orders to the best of its knowledge and ability, however in the event of a late delivery or wrong shipment, SWS Nijhof B.V. will under no circumstances be liable for any form of damage resulting from this.

European EU-station: NL-8486: we have a certificate for shipping fresh and frozen semen from our stallions to countries outside of the Netherlands. Please take note that we have to inform the NVWA in time about the export. Please register your stud in the European Database for Traces. Your destination must be validated there, otherwise we can not send the semen.

Livery charges at SWS Nijhof BV are € 8,50, – (excl. VAT) per day per mare without a foal and € 12, – (excl. VAT) for a mare with a foal at foot.

The veterinary costs for palpation and scanning are € 125, – (excl. VAT and medicines and other actions), if you use a stallion from Team Nijhof. For other stallions, frozen semen or self-brought semen the veterinary costs for breeding management are € 350, – (excl VAT). The mares must be at least three years old to be inseminated.
